

GOLF COURSE RULES

Play by the USGA Rules of Golf.

General Rules

- Reservations for tee times are encouraged. Especially on weekends and holidays. Call our Pro Shop at (559) 439-2712.
- Walk-ons are welcome so long as tee times are available.
- Arrive at the facility 15-20 minutes prior to your reserved tee time so you're ready to go off the tee at your scheduled time.
- No more than 4 players per group.
- Check in with the Starter located at then end of the range line.
- Each player should use their own clubs.
- All holes on the golf course are to be played in proper order.
- Pace of play is an important part of golf. If you're playing slow and the group behind you is waiting, PLEASE allow that group to play through.
- Repair your ball marks on the putting greens.
- Repair/replace your divots on the tee boxes and fairways.
- Do not use golf balls from the driving range on the golf course.
- Only putters can be used on the putting greens.
- Be courteous and respectful to others on the golf course.
- Non-Players are included in the number of people in a group. Non-Players must pay a \$5 walking fee.
- Last, but not least, HAVE FUN!

For Your Safety

Our golf course is 9 holes and much more condensed than an 18-hole golf course. All holes are in close proximity to other holes or the driving range. That said:

- No infants or toddlers are allowed on the golf course.
- All minors under the age of 10 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
- Watch for errant golf balls from the driving range while playing on hole #8 & hole #9. These holes are adjacent to the driving range.
- Do not enter the ponds!!!
